NOTIFICATION

The schedule of Scholarships (Revised) applicable in the academic session 2025-26 at Hindustan Campus Colleges is enclosed herewith:-

1. **Merit Scholarship:** Based on the academic performance of the students (as per the criteria defined in the Schedule "A" and "B") enclosed.
2. **Vidushi Scholarship:** Rs. 10000/- scholarship above 65% marks (PCM/B) in qualifying exam applicable only for Girl Students who will opt for B.Tech, BBA, BCA courses in Hindustan College and Science and Technology. Not payable if the student is recipient of any other scholarship. Minimum 80% class attendance to be maintained and 65% + aggregate marks in the previous two semesters need to be maintained for continuation of Scholarship in subsequent years (Details enclosed)
3. **Community Referrals Scholarships / Reward:** Rs. 10000/- for B.Tech/MBA/MCA, M.Tech for admission through Alumni/ Student/ Faculty/ Staff reference, can be waived off in the Tuition fee of the student who has opted for Hindustan College of Science and Technology/ HIMCS courses as outlined above once in the initial year at the time of admission to the student or alternatively granted to the referring person as referral reward. (**other terms and conditions are defined in the referral policy 2025-26 enclosed*). In any one of the above cases; the total number is subject to a maximum 20% of approved seat capacity of the Campus College/ Branch. Community referral advantage will not be offered to the applicants and student who is recipient of any other scholarship (in CS & allied branches only 15% seats) (Details enclosed)
4. **Employee Ward Scholarship:** 25% or 50% tuition fee waived off for the ward of a serving employee of the Campus/ Group by Competent Authority, depending respectively if the employee has put in more than 5 or 10 years of service. In case of employee having put in >15 year services and his/her annual take home earning (excluding PF/ESI etc) being less than 8 lacs rupees per annum, 60% of tuition fee waiver will be granted. (Details Enclosed).
5. **Caution Money:** The caution Money charged in fee will be exempted in special cases only with the permission of Competent Authorities in writing e.g. Admission Head/ Director.
6. Scholarship for Wards of Defence Personnel / Zonal/ State level Sports persons/ students with demonstrated innovation achievements/ Siblings. (Details enclosed)

- Note:** (a) *Only one scholarship / exemption can be offered to the student whichever is highest in monetary terms.*
(b) *For CSE and allied Courses only 20% of the students of total intake seat capacity can be offered Merit Scholarship, whereas in other branches up to 25% students can be awarded Merit Scholarships.*

In case of non fulfilment of minimum eligible marks criteria in 1st year / subsequent years the scholarship will be cancelled for the next year. A Scholarship once cancelled shall not be renewed or restored under any circumstances.

(●) The minimum class attendance, semesterwise in the first year / or qualifying year should be at least 80% or more, for continuation of the scholarship in next year, otherwise the scholarship will not be continued.

3. Employee Ward Scholarship

1. Applicable for all courses.

2. 25% OR 50% tuition fee waived off to the ward of the employee by competent authority, depending respectively if the employee has more than 5 or 10 Years of service respectively in Sharda Group of Institutions. For wards of employees of other than Hindustan Campus, the employee has to produce a letter from concerned HR deptt. certifying the employment tenure.

3. In exceptional cases 60% of tuition fee waiver will be granted to employee wards of employees who have put in more than 15 years of services in the Group and their yearly income for all sources is less than 8 lakhs rupees per year.

4. Scholarship for Wards of Defence Personnel / State / Zone level Sports persons/ students with demonstrated innovation achievements/ Siblings

1. Scholarship worth 10% of the Tution fee shall be granted to these category of students over the full course duration (#). The criteria for accepting good innovation achevment / or sports achievment shall lie with the College Competenet Authority.

(#) The scholarship for 2nd year onward will be continued only if the scholar secures minimum 65% or more marks in the Ist years (or previous year) in aggregate (60% in case of sports scholarship holders) in each of the semester examinations, which determines his/her promotion to next higher class/year. In case of non fulfilment of minimum eligible marks criteria in Ist year / subsequent years the scholarship will be cancelled for the next year. The Scholarship once cancelled shall not be renewed or restored under any circumstances.

(I) The minimum class attendance, semesterwise in the first year / or qualifying year should be at least 80% or more (for sports scholarship holder 60% or more), for continuation of the scholaship in next year, otherwise the scholarship will not be continued.

5. Community Referrals Scholarships / Reward

Student/ Employee-Staff-Faculty Referral Scholarship for Admissions:-

Policy and Process : if a current student refers and motivates a friend or relative to seek admission, he/ she shall become eligible for "Referral Incentive" as given below. In case a faculty/ Staff/ Employee refers a student for admission the incentive will be in the form of "Loyalty Rewards".

Note:

- The Faculty/ Staff may get the loyalty reward credited in their A/c which shall be remitted to their A/c in the month of Sep for the case of students the same can be in the form of tution fee credit in their account. OR
- They may choose to extend the credit to the students whom they have referred, (so that the benifit can be availed by the admitted student). in such a case no additional incentive will be given to referring student/ employee-faculty-staff. Such cases will be called "Community Referral Scholarship".

- The referral incentive/ reward will be payable after September; after enrollment of the referred student and payment of fees by the student.
- In case an Alumni refers a student for admission the advantage of an amount as given in table can be passed on to the admitted student in the form of reduced tuition fee in the 1st year (One time Scholarship).
- In case the monetary advantage is given to the referred student, the counselor has to record on the application the name of the referring Staff/ Faculty/Alumni clearly mentioning name/ details (Including phone numbers) before granting referral amount.
- If the monetary benefit, is being passed on to the referring person (Student/ Alumni/Faculty/ Staff) a "**Claim Form**" duly signed by the referee has to be submitted and the counselor has to authenticate the same with his /her signature/ approval.
- Referral advantages can be given to a maximum of 15% students of CS/DS/IOT/AI&ML courses (on the approved seat capacity) and to 20% of the seat capacity in other branches.
